What Is the Teacher Forum?

At Beyond100K, we unite over 200 leading STEM organizations to co-develop and implement solutions that will **end the STEM teacher shortage by 2043**, especially for those most excluded from STEM opportunities.

But, we know that too often programs and policies are designed without teacher input. That's why we launched the **Teacher Forum** to help fill that gap by listening to STEM teachers from across the country and sharing insights with our network and the field. Teacher Forum members hold a unique leadership position in our national STEM teaching network and contribute to our mission to get and keep great STEM teachers in all our nation's schools.

The main way we engage the Teacher Forum is through virtual listening sessions, where Teacher Forum members will share their thoughts, experiences, and stories about what is happening on the ground in STEM classrooms across the country. The insights shared during these conversations help Beyond100K and our network partners better understand STEM teachers' opinions, ideas, struggles, and successes, as well as inform the national conversation around STEM education and improve STEM teaching and learning.
